


Production

- Battling for your Customer confidences










Testing

- Non-Destructive
 - Discover substandard attributes
 - Visual, Xray, XRF, Electrical
 - C-SAM, Dye Penetrant, SEM
- Destructive
 - Confirms substandard attributes
 - De-Cap, PIND, RGA,
 - Bond pull, Die shear





MISSTALL RESTRICTOR.



Reporting and Disposition

- Reporting
 - ERAI/GIDEP
 - Internal
 - Customers
 - Product recall



- Disposition -
 - Quarantined
 - Not to reenter the supply chain
